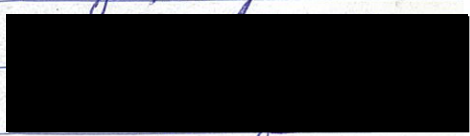

all their joints.

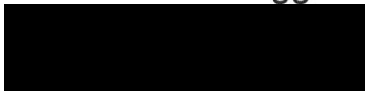
The 3rd house in Price St has a very antique shed back wall which I suppose has a certain~~ly~~ historical charm as an old dunny is opposite.

Thanks for the invitation to comment on the naming of the laneways in Denmark.

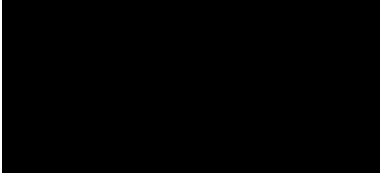

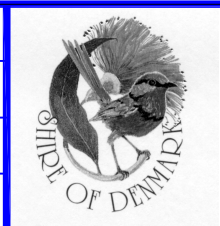
