

Seasonal Harmony Celebrations

Project Starting Date: August 2012

Description of Project:

Niah Kartijin Coolingars wish to organise two seasonal events to be held within selected Shire of Denmark Reserves with a focus on on-country experience. These events will be outdoors, alcohol free and encourage full family participation (suitable for all ages).

Kambarang – October 2012 - Bush Tucker Walk and Cook up: Participants will learn the indicators of the season, Noongar names for plants and animals and good eating tucker and medicine on a bush walk guided by Cultural Educators within a selected Shire of Denmark Reserve. Participants will then enjoy a bush food cook up. We held this event last year and there was such a great response and interest with approximately 80 people attending so we would like to repeat it this year.

Djeran – March 2013 – Harmony Day Walk and Celebration: Participants will undertake a Harmony Day walk within a selected Shire of Denmark Reserve and participate in oral and artistic cultural activities with Cultural Educators such as basket weaving and the creation of a giant earth art mural using natural materials.

Objectives of Project:

- To enhance people's connection to their local environment by exploring Noongar culture, language and traditions associated with the places they live.
- To create a cross-cultural sharing environment for the community with an emphasis on learning and exchange through on-country experience, storytelling, music, dance, drama and visual arts.
- To develop the skills of Indigenous and non-Indigenous cultural educators and artists in promoting our unique culture.
- To provide an understanding of the nature of modern Noongar culture.
- To build strong and respectful relationships between cultures in order to heal the wounds of the past.

How does this project support the aims of the Cultural Development Fund?

This project will build on the Noongar cultural knowledge and network that Niah Kartijin Coolingars: Listen, Learn Children Inc. have developed over the last two years to facilitate cultural activities in the Shire of Denmark. This project will extend the range of cultural activities within the Shire by encouraging participants, facilitators and cultural educators to come together to increase and share their knowledge of the local environment through on-country experience. This project will enhance cultural awareness and appreciation of Noongar culture and the local environment within which we live. The Denmark community will have the opportunity to interact with Noongar people and cultural educators. These events will be outdoors, alcohol free and encourage full family participation (suitable for all ages).

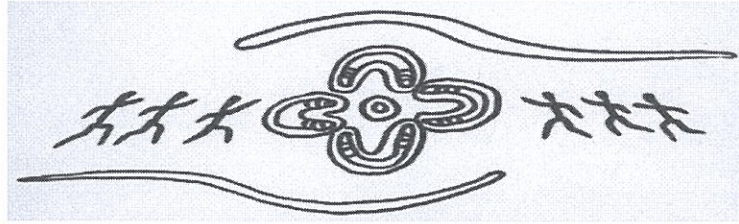
