2. REPORTS & PRESENTATIONS

2.1 Denmark Arts Council Inc.

Denmark Arts made their annual presentation to Councillors. The presentation included a summary of activities delivered during 2017/18. Organisation turnover for the previous period was \$635,000 with 73% expended locally.

The group suggested various initiatives for Council to consider moving forward including more public art to increase visitor numbers, honour our historical and cultural identity and conveying our reputation as an artistic town.

2.2 Corporate Planning Update

The Shire's Corporate Planning Officer, Teiga Murray, attended the meeting and provided an update on the Integrated Planning and Reporting Framework. This included the results of the 1000 minds assessment and project evaluation tool. The tool assesses all project against the Shire's Strategic Community Plan and also assesses all financial implications associated with each project.

The update also included progress reports on the Long Term Financial Plan, Workforce Plan and Corporate Business Plan. The Corporate Planning Officer also discussed the benchmarking survey, that will be distributed to residents randomly.
