  - Due to the seasonally changing depth of the Inlet water and sandbank formations, the arbitrary boundary across these
    waters does not allow for the safe access for dogs and owners to the Nullaki and the beach.
  - This area is of great significance to the fabric of the dog community, young and old, both for their mental and physical
    health providing them with a safe, accessible area to engage with other people whilst also socialising their dogs.
