REFUSE DISPOSAL INFORMATION

Denmark Waste Management & Reuse Facility (DWMRF) and Peaceful Bay Landfill are designed and licensed to accommodate a Transfer Station, Drop-Off Centre for Recycling, Inert Waste Landfilling, Asbestos Disposal (DWMRF) and Green Waste Disposal.

Please follow the directions of the Site Attendant/Landfill Operator and dispose of your waste in the appropriate areas. This will minimise the amount of movement of heavy equipment to clean up the area, keeping dust/earth movement to a minimum, plus creating a more efficient and cost effective operation.

In the interest of public health and safety, please make sure children and pets do not leave your vehicle.

As part of Occupational, Health and Safety and insurance guidelines, but also in the paramount interest of personal safety, the scavenging of materials at the refuse sites is not permitted.

Motor vehicles,(Please remove tyres, all fluids, fuel tanks and batteries from vehicles before disposal). white goods and fencing wire are accepted at both sites. Gas bottles must be empty and inspected by the gate attendant prior to disposal. Fridges, air-conditioning units and heat pumps must be degassed with proof provided to the gate attendant before disposal. Scrap metal dealers make periodic visits to recycle these items.

Asbestos disposal requires certain conditions be met by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation. If you require information relating to the disposal, or a license to cart asbestos, please contact the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation or the Shire of Denmark for details. For information on the disposal of hazardous wastes, assistance may be sought from the Shire by phoning **08 9848 0300.** The waste disposal fee structure is designed to encourage residents to sort household rubbish prior to disposal to achieve maximum recycling. In doing so, residents will achieve cost savings and contribute to the reduction of waste to landfill.

Recycling is an integral part of the principle of reducing waste to landfill and both sites currently recycle the following items:



Note: Household batteries and fluorescent light globes/tubes, used engine oil, aerosols and mobile phones are accepted for recycling at DWMRF Car and truck batteries are accepted at Tip Shop.

Green Skills operate the Tip Shop at DWMRF and will accept reusable items at the Site Operator's discretion. For any questions, please contact **Green Skills on 08 9848 3310** or visit the Tip Shop.

Consumers can help minimise the waste going to landfill and minimise the impact of increases in waste disposal fees by:

- Using of Worm Farms or Composting Bins
- Purchasing products in materials/packaging that is readily recycled and avoid highly packaged materials.
- Sorting wastes into different categories prior to disposal. (as listed below).
- Separate recyclables from general waste.

WASTE CATEGORIES

- Clean Green Waste all vegetative material that is not mixed with any other waste type. Large logs over 200mm diameter will not be accepted.
- 2. Inert Waste (Non-Contaminated i.e. no timber, steel, plastic) Wastes that are largely non-biodegradable, non-flammable and not chemically reactive.
 - Clean fill which consists of rocks or soil arising from the excavation of largely undisturbed material that does not contain harmful contaminants.
 - Building and demolition waste (e.g. bricks, concrete, but excluding timber) being material resulting from the demolition, erection, construction, refurbishment or alteration of buildings or from the construction, repair or alteration of infrastructuretype development such as roads, which is not mixed with any other type of waste, and does not contain asbestos.
- **3. General Waste** is classed as waste that has not been sorted for recycling or to go to landfill. E.g. General household rubbish and non-recyclables. Including treated timber.
- 4. Recyclable Waste all materials shown in the diagram before, scrap metal and inert waste that can be re-used (note: the Tip shop attendant will establish if product is re-usable or not).
- 5. E-waste Only the following E-Waste Items are accepted for recycling: Computers, CRT/Plasma/LCD TVs and Monitors and computer peripherals including printers and copiers. For other electrical equipment (vacuums, power tools etc) please see the attendant for correct disposal.
