#### OUTLINE

The War Memorial

The Denmark RSL has been preparing for and has received approval from the Denmark Shire, to move the War Memorial approximately 8m back on the block where it now exists.

The quoted cost of the project from Bernie Malatzky was \$52,455 plus GST with exclusions of no liability if damage to any of the heritage items.

The Department of Veteran's Affairs has also awarded a grant of \$4,000 (inc GST) for contribution to the works.

Also requested at the time of submitting grant applications was the removal of the power pole on the footpath of the Memorial. The power pole will cause a safety issue with the Memorial moved back to the new location as it will be directly in front of the parade path on

ANZAC Days. The removal was quoted by Western Power to be approx \$53,000. No grant has been received for this part of the project.

The RSL Hall - Strickland St

The Denmark RSL applied for a grant from the CFAP for 2011/2012 for several items with a total requested amount of \$9,523.61. An amount of \$2,000 was granted to complete a verandah over the two Bent St entrances, and to replace two doors.

Following a discussion with Gary Bird, DFin Denmark Shire, this amount was transferred from that project to other parts of the funding request: the relocation of the Gun currently on the corner of Bent and Strickland Sts, the building of a parapet around the gun, replacing the vegetation on the Strickland St frontage with a more suitable variety, creating a pathway from Strickland St up to the RSL Hall, and placing a cover over the gun. The cover over the gun was to be \$5,965. The other works were possibly to be covered by the Shire.

#### **FUNDING IMPLICATIONS**

2 grants have been received, both of which are to be expended on the War Memorial refurbishment.

There is no funding for the removal of the power pole.

The Lotteries grant covers everything if there are no breakages. Lotteries Comm have advised that if there are breakages creating further costs, go back to them for another grant to rectify.

There is the DVA Grant of \$4,000 to be spent on the project.

The Shire has approved a grant of \$11,000 (inc GST) for the project.

The Shire has approved a grant of \$2,000 for the RSL Hall precinct upgrade.

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#### SOLUTION

- The RSL commits the \$4,000 from DVA to the memorial, reducing the Shire's contribution to the Memorial to \$7,000.
- The Shire's CFAP \$2,000 allocation to the Denmark RSL be augmented by the \$4,000 not now being spent on the memorial. This gives \$6,000 to provide the gun cover.
- The Shire works department supplies the works required to tidy up the Strickland St frontage, build the rock parapet around the gun and supplies the brick paving for the gun site. (Note, there will be spare brick paving available from the memorial site when those works are commenced).
- The Shire approaches Western Power to remove the power pole and opts to pay the costs over a period of time.

#### TIME LINE

It is anticipated that works will commence as soon as possible after the 11<sup>th</sup> November, and be completed in time for ANZAC Day 2012. The builder has indicated the Memorial upgrade would not take longer than approx 2 months.

It is not known how long the Western Power works will take.

Prior to work commencing on the Memorial site, there is to be a heritage survey conducted. I spoke with and wrote to the Shire CEO on Oct 12<sup>th</sup> and requested that the survey be conducted. The advice from Dale was it would take approx a month to conduct and complete.


### COMMENT

## Re: War Memorial Relocation

In response to your request to relocate the War Memorial on Reserve 19050, I am pleased to advise that Council considered the matter at their November 2010 meetings and on the 23 November 2010 resolved as follows;

"That with respect to the Denmark RSL Sub-Branch's request to relocate the War Memorial on Reserve 19050, at Lot 205 South Coast Highway, Denmark, further back onto the same Reserve,

1. Grant approval for the project subject to the retention of the existing Conifer Tree;

2. Provide letters of support for funding application/s made by the Denmark RSL Sub-Branch for

3. Agree to including a financial contribution of \$11,000 (inc. GST), reflecting cash and/or in-kind services, in the 2011/2012 Municipal Budget towards the cost of the project, subject to confirmation of approval of external funding application/s and the Denmark RSL Sub-Branch confirming, by June 2011, that they have sufficient funds to complete the project in 2011/12;

4. Request that the Denmark RSL Sub-Branch undertake a Heritage Assessment/Impact Statement of the site (which can be funded in 2011/12 from the Council's financial contribution), provide a

copy of it to Council and comply with any recommendations contained therein; and

5. Require the Denmark RSL Sub-Branch to lodge a Building Application noting that the need for submitting a development application and advertising is waived, given it is on Council land and that they have demonstrated significant consultation with their members.

6. Council fees are waived pursuant to Policy P100606."

Please note however that the request to have the Lone Pine tree planted within this reserve was not supported due to concerns about the size and invasiveness root nature of the tree. In this regard I invite you to liaise with Council's Supervisor Parks and Gardens, Mr Andrew Brinsden to discuss options for its location.

Celebrating 100 years of Local Government in 2011

In relation to the Heritage Assessment/Impact Statement I advise that contact can be made with Council's Senior Planner, Ms Cindy Simpson to discuss progressing this in the 2011/12 year, should you wish to proceed. I have received a verbal quotation from a local Heritage Architect of approximately \$500-\$1000 to undertake this task.

I wish you well with sourcing funds for this project and please let me know if you require any letters of support to include with funding applications.



I, Mr Mark Davies, President of the Denmark RSL Sub-branch, accept the offer of a grant of \$4,000 from the Minister for Veterans' Affairs. This grant will help to refurbish and relocate the Denmark War Memorial. I:

- (a) agree that the grant and any asset formed as a result of the grant will be used solely for the purpose specified in the Minister's letter of offer of grant;
- (b) agree that the grantee bears full responsibility, including liability, for all activities carried out in relation to the project;
- (c) agree to return, signed, the Acquittal Form enclosed, to the Australian Government Department of Veterans' Affairs, certifying that the full amount has been spent on the project for which the grant was made, or that any surplus funds have been remitted to the Department. This form should be returned to the Department no later than 31 March 2012;
- (d) agree to provide the Department of Veterans' Affairs in writing by the date referred to in (c) above the reason the funds cannot be acquitted by the due date, a request for the project timeframe to be extended (for consideration by the Department) and the date by which the acquittal will be provided;
- (e) agree to retain all records relating to this grant, and the project, for which it was awarded for a period no less than two years from the date of the Minister's letter of offer;
- (f) agree to provide the Department of Veterans' Affairs with a photograph or copy of anything produced as a result of the grant (eg, books, orders of service, etc) and that these may be used, where appropriate, by the Department for commemorative and promotional purposes in its publications, including websites and brochures;
- (g) agree to acknowledge that the project is supported by funding from the Australian Government under the Saluting Their Service Commemorations program;
- (h) agree to disclosure of the recipient's name and details of the project as required under Commonwealth Government grant publication requirements on the Department of Veterans' Affairs website for at least two years, in media releases, letters announcing the grant to Members of the Parliament of Australia, the Australian National Audit Office and as required to meet Government accountability requirements;
- (i) agree to attempt settlement of any dispute by negotiation with the Department of Veterans' Affairs before resorting to external dispute resolution processes;
- (j) note that this grant must be acquitted before future grants can be accepted;




