Welcome to the Mokare Walk Trail

The Mokare Walk Trail is a 3km circuit that follows both sides of the Denmark River between the South Coast Highway Bridge and the former rail bridge at the Rivermouth. Allow 45 minutes to walk the circuit which was named after Mokare, an Aboriginal tribal leader from the Albany area who accompanied Dr Thomas Braidwood Wilson on his 1829 expedition to the Denmark district.

This trail is subject to seasonal flooding, generally when the water level of the Denmark River and Wilson Inlet is above 600mm AHD.
