“Commercial & Industrial Zone” Community Workshop for Local Planning Scheme No. 4

To assist with the preparation of draft Local Planning Scheme No. 4 (LPS 4), the community is invited to attend a “Commercial & Industrial Zone” Community Workshop to be held on the 25 June 2014 from 7pm–9pm at the Shire of Denmark Council Chambers.

Cr Ross Thornton, Shire President said “Councillors are keen for the community’s input as to what they like and what they do not like in relation to land development related matters for the Denmark CBD, the ‘Mixed Business’ area (current Light Industrial Area), the ‘Service Park’ area (corner of Denmark-Mt Barker Road & South Coast Highway) and the ‘Industrial’ area (off McIntosh Road). In this regard issues including, but not limited to, land uses, height, setbacks, car parking requirements for private developments and signage provisions are all proposed to be discussed and the feedback from the workshops will assist Council in formulating the associated LPS 4 provisions”.

Councillor Thornton added “The format of the workshop will comprise an initial powerpoint presentation and then focus groups, which will be facilitated by Shire Councillors, will be formed for workshop participants to provide their ideas and thoughts on each of the discussions topics. By Shire Councillors facilitating the focus group discussions it will provide them with first-hand opportunities to engage with the workshop participants”.

The “Commercial & Industrial” Zone Community Workshop follows on from the recent Community Engagement Sessions conducted in Nornalup and Denmark on the 15 and 20 May 2014 respectively. These initial community engagement sessions sought to inform the community about the role of a Planning Scheme and its associated processes.
