

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR TUSS?

The Taxi Users' Subsidy Scheme (TUSS) provides taxi travel at a reduced rate for eligible clients.

Eligibility:

Permanent residents of Western Australia who have a permanent disability which falls within the specified categories of:

- severe mobility disability
- severe vision disability (legal blindness); and
- severe cognitive/intellectual disability

How do I apply?

If you consider you may be eligible for TUSS, you will need to complete an Application Form available from the Department of Transport.

COUNTRY AGE PENSION FUEL CARD

The Country Age Pension Fuel Card provides eligible pensioners with up to \$575 a year towards the cost of fuel and/or taxi travel from participating providers to offer more support for the transport needs of eligible pensioners living in country areas.

The Country Age Pension Fuel Card Scheme is funded by the State Government's Royalties for Regions program and administered by the Department of Transport.

Eligibility:

You must be receiving one of the following pensions: Centrelink Age Pension, Carer Payment, Disability Support Pension, Wife Pension, Widow B Pension, Department of Veterans' Affairs Service Pension, Social Security Age Pension or Income Support Supplement ; and
Live in an eligible regional location.
