



WELCOME TO PARRY'S BEACH CAMPGROUND



The Parry's Beach Reserve & Camping area is managed by the Parry's Beach Voluntary Management Group Inc. (PBVMG) for the Shire of Denmark.

No one receives any payment for the work they do such as cleaning toilets, collecting camping fees etc. All money goes to the Shire and is spent on the upkeep and maintenance of the Reserve. It is only with your co-operation that we can continue to keep this place in its relatively unspoilt state for ourselves and future generations to enjoy.

It is your campsite and home while you are here so please assist us in abiding by the
Campground Rules.

1. **Caretaker** can be contacted between 9am - 12pm and 1 -5pm (and after hours for emergencies).
2. **Maximum stay** of 3 weeks.
3. **Unoccupied** caravans, trailers, tents etc may not be left in this campground. Any vans/equipment left unattended for more than 24 hours will be removed if the caretaker considers that you are using it to save a site prior to a busy period - *even if you have paid camp fees.*
4. Saving spots for friends is not permitted.
5. Consult the caretaker before moving to another site within the campground.
6. **Pop-up shower/toilet** tents are not allowed.
7. Dispose of all **rubbish** in bins provided past the BBQ area. A special unit is provided for **fish offal and meat scraps** *unwrapped or in paper* (no plastic in this bin please) – located past rubbish bins.
8. No **fish cleaning** within campground – a table is provided on the beach.
9. Quiet **generators** are permitted and can only be used between 8–10 am and 5–9 pm.
10. Friendly **dogs** are welcome and must be kept on a leash in the campground.
11. Beware of snakes, deadly species live here. Keep you kids and dogs out of bush areas.
12. All vehicles (including motor bikes) are to be driven slowly and responsibly through the campsite (5kms/hr) and on the beach.
13. All **washing water** is to be deposited into the sinks and not to run onto the ground at your site.
14. Please make sure that your **gas bottles** are within govt regulation and are in good working order.
15. **Fire extinguishers** are found throughout camp ground. Please note where your closest fire extinguisher is located.
16. **Family shower** is located in the front ablution block. **Disabled facilities** are located in each ablution block.
17. Water is heated from **solar panels**, hot water will not always be available. An **outdoor shower** is located at front ablution block for washing off sand prior to showering.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

In case of emergency all persons must turn off all gas and extinguish fires.
Move as quickly as possible to the Evacuation area (front BBQ area) to receive further instructions.

Please do not bring your camping equipment or van etc.

FIRE RULES

- **Firewood** is available (at cost price) from the caretaker's cottage until 5pm daily.
- Please use the fire pits provided only.
- Fires may only be lit after **5pm (Summer) and all day (Winter)** and must never be left unattended. Extinguish them before going to bed.
- **Campfire bans**– caretaker will notify campers and no wood will be on sale.
- **Absolutely NO collecting firewood in the park or reserve.**
- You may BYO firewood but it must be small size pieces (fit inside the fire drum).
- Please be gentle with our wheelbarrows and return them as soon as you deliver your wood to campsite.
- Any breach of fire rules will result in eviction.

Please take extra care with your camp fires – mistakes may cost lives!
