Cr Carman asked the following question.

1. Has staff undertaken a desktop search to identify what other shires in Western Australia, or even in other regions, are implementing with regard to standalone Sexual Harassment (SH) policies? I have observed that the Shire of Jerramungup has a policy which appears to be operational rather than a formal council policy, and it has only recently been updated. Additionally, other shires I have reviewed seem less transparent, with available information limited to codes of conduct. Could staff provide insight or findings on this matter?

Officers have consulted with other local governments and will implement a Discrimination, Harassment, and Bullying Operation Standard, including measures to address sexual harassment. This standard will adhere to various federal and state laws to ensure a safe and equitable workplace.
