In respect to part 4 of the Local Government (Functions and General) Regulations 1996, the Chief Executive Officer is delegated authority to perform the following:

- a) Publicly invite tenders for the supply of goods and services when the CEO believes that a tender process will deliver the best outcome for Council.
(Reference: Regulations 11 (1), 12 and 13)
- b) Determine, in writing, the criteria for deciding which tenders should be accepted and give Statewide public notice.
(Reference: Regulation 14)
- c) To accept or reject tenders that do not exceed \$250,000 (excepting (d)), provided that appropriate provision is made in Council's Budget.
(Reference: Regulation 18)
- d) To accept or reject Tender No. TEN.1.20/21 – Lights Beach Upgrade providing the consideration does not exceed \$750,000 and provided that appropriate provision is made in Council's Budget.
(Reference: Regulation 18)

The Chief Executive Officer in exercising authority under Section 5.44 of the Local Government Act 1995 has delegated this power/duty ((a) and (b) only) to the relevant Director; for the supply of goods and services within that officer's area of responsibility.
