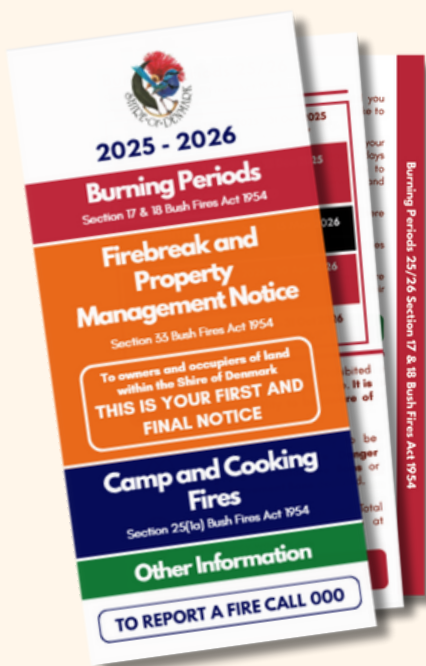


2025/2026 Firebreak and Property Management Notice

This notice outlines your responsibilities in reducing bushfire risks on your property during the upcoming fire season.

Property inspections will be carried out by our Authorised Officers between 1 December 2025 and 30 April 2026, and fines will be issued for non-compliance.

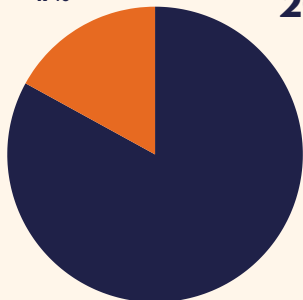


Your property may be inspected more than once, and even if your property passes an initial inspection, it must be maintained throughout the entire fire season to remain compliant.

Authorised Officers are legally entitled to enter your property, without your permission, to conduct property compliance inspections.
