

Dear Neighbour,

I am writing to bring to your attention a matter regarding your cat, which has been wandering onto my property and causing a nuisance. While I understand that you may not have been aware of this situation occurring in the neighborhood, I feel it is important to address it promptly.

According to the **Shire of Denmark Cats Local Law 2020, section 3.1**, the owner or occupier of premises on which a cat is ordinarily kept shall prevent the cat from creating a nuisance on other premises, to another person or exposing another person to health and/or safety risks by:

- (a) The noise or odour generated by the presence of the cat/s;
- (b) The aggressive nature of the cat/s; or
- (c) A cat that wanders outside the premises where it is ordinarily kept.

To avoid any further action required by the Shire Rangers which may result in a fine or penalty, I kindly request that you take the necessary steps to ensure your cat remains contained within your property. I bring this matter to your attention to allow you the opportunity to rectify the situation.
