Important Information for Cat Owners

A cat owner is required to update the Local Government where the cat is registered and the relevant microchip database company within seven days if there are any changes to the information that either organisation is required to keep.

In addition to the Cat Registration tag, a cat must also have a tag inscribed with the owners name and address,

The maximum number of cats to be kept on any premises is two over the age of six months. Approval can be sought from the Local Government to keep more than two cats under certain conditions.

The definition of a pensioner is for concessional licensing purposes is a person issued with a Pensioner Health Benefit Card (i.e. Carers Pension, Aged Pension, Invalid Pension, Widowed Pension, Supporting Parents Pension).
